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#### What is the Problem





- If insurance fraud was a legitimate business enterprise, it would rank among Fortune 500 Companies.
- Insurance fraud is the second most committed crime after income tax evasion.
- Over the period from 2011 to 2015, there was a 29.9% increase in QCs referred to NICB, going from 93,111 in 2011 to 120,951 in 2015.
- In 2015, the top five states generating the most QCs were:
  California, Florida, Texas, New York and Michigan. These five states account for 49% of all questionable insurance claims in the U.S.

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#### **How Did We Get Here?**

- Over 38% of the people interviewed in a 2015 NICB poll thought there was nothing wrong with exaggerating injuries to get more money.
- 78% of those surveyed felt they could commit insurance fraud and get away with it because the insurance company would not thoroughly investigate their claim.
- In most cases insurance fraud is not a high dollar or "high profile" case and as such there has been a failure of state and local governments to aggressively prosecute fraud.

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### **Abuse vs Fraud**

- Abuse Any practice that uses the insurance claims system in a way that is contrary to either the intended purpose of the system or the law.
- ABOSE
  - Approximately 55% to 60% of all insurance claims have abuse
- Fraud These claims have the elements of fraud, a material lie that was told intentionally and knowingly. But these cases of fraud can only be prosecuted if these elements are uncovered through investigation and can be proven beyond a reasonable doubt.
  - Approximately 8% to 10% are fraudulent

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### **Vehicle Sighting Reports**


- Determine the locations a vehicle has visited
- Date, time, latitude, longitude and address
- Photos of vehicle and license plate.
- · Not real-time
- Good for establishing patterns and locations of activity
- Coverage in all states





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



































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# **Geo Fencing**

Geo-fence searching allows investigators to create a perimeter for a real-world geographic area and filter any items indexed with Geo-Data that fall within that area. This technology allows for the potential to obtain the following information:

- · Potential witnesses to an incident
- · Video or images taken of an incident
- · Comments posted about a particular incident
- · Comments posted by a party to a claim

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
















# **High Exposure Claim**



- The subject was involved in a three vehicle minor impact accident.
- He was claiming severe back and neck injuries that required
- He was also claiming a variety of physical limitations including no prolonged sitting or standing.
- He claimed he was no longer able to work and his claim included future loss of earnings.



## **High Exposure Claim**



- Subject lived in very rural area of Northern CA making surveillance extremely difficult.
- A comprehensive background and social media investigation was conducted and revealed the following:
  - Lawsuits involving pre-existing injuries to the same body parts
  - Involvement in selling occult/horror dolls at horror conventions
  - Determined he would be selling these items at an event at the Sacramento Convention Center
